CLASS INFO

One of the unsung heroes of the Police K9 world is the bloodhound. Though they are an important part of police service dog industry, there is not much training out there for K9 Bloodhound teams.

This seminar is designed for the new or experienced bloodhound team. Topics covered include emergency K9 first aid and triage, trailing philosophies, principles of beginning a track combined with man tracking skills and actual field work. This is a physically demanding course designed to teach new skills or hone existing skills around the proper use of the bloodhound team.

The teams will be in the field two of the three days engaged in actual tracks. The tracks are lengthy woodland and urban tracks designed to expose the team to different terrains, scents and distractions that they may encounter in the field. We strive to provide the most realistic and relevant training to our attendees so real life evaluations of performance can be obtained. Block seats are available for agencies sending 4 or more teams.
