CLASS INFO

It is often said that a good dog can make a bad handler look good. We also know that a bad decoy can ruin a good dog. Therefore, quality instruction of the decoy is paramount in the progression of a dog team or unit. Whether you are a new or seasoned handler, instructor or anyone else wanting improve your decoy work, this class is for you. We use time honored methods of training our handlers to be great decoys thereby enabling them to train the best dog allowable based on the dog's limitations.

This class takes the decoy through the various stages of training a police service dog from the decoy's prospective. Learning what not to do and what to do better to trigger the desired instinctive and behavioral response from the dog based on its natural drives and traits. We focus on decoy and dog interaction as well as coaching of the decoy by the handler.

This three day seminar is designed to take the newest of handler or the most veteran handler to the top of decoy performance to foster a self correcting and self sustaining K9 unit. This is a physically demanding class but is designed to bring everyone up to a better level of performance.
